

Planting Your Tree

Your seedling has been grown in a peat moss mixture to protect the roots and hold moisture. Remove the plastic tube before planting, but do not remove the peat moss.

Plant your seedling in a container at least twice as deep as the roots are long and with nutrient-rich potting soil. The seedling will grow best if the soil is kept moist and the pot is located outside. After about a year, your seedling will be ready to transplant into the ground.

When choosing a permanent site

Pick a spot with good soil, away from power lines and least 10 feet from buildings and sidewalks. Your tree will need plenty of sunlight and deep watering, but not too often.
